About the Trade:

- 1. All buildings have plumbing and heating many have cooling also
- 2. Paper mills, mines, refineries, and electrical powerhouses provide materials and utilities used by all industrial piping is a large portion of these facilities
- 3. Work may be in residential, commercial, or industrial sites
- 4. All construction work is cyclical there will be busy times and times between jobs

About the Local:

- 1. We cover the entire Upper Peninsula and Niagara, WI. Members who wish to travel may also work throughout the United States and Canada
- 2. Facets of the plumber/pipefitter trade include:
 - a. Plumbing
 - b. Heating, Cooling, and Boilers
 - c. Industrial Piping
 - d. Pipe Welding

Our Apprenticeship:

- 1. 5 years of primarily on-the-job paid training
- 2. 216 hours of classroom training per year
- 3. Work full-time while learning
- 4. Starting pay is \$19.32/hr, raises every 6 months until completion starting pay ~\$36k/year for a typical year
- 5. Journeyman pay is \$38.63/hr ~ \$77k/year for a typical year
- 6. Pension, Annuity, Healthcare with Medical Reimbursement Account paid above hourly rate pension contributions start 2nd year

Earn approximately \$254,000 plus benefits during 5 year apprenticeship while working towards Journeyman status

Requirements:

- 1. Basic math and communication skills
- 2. Minimum age/education level to apply 17 years old and HS Senior (or equivalent) to apply; 18 years old and HS graduate (or equivalent) to enter program
- 3. Ability to pass background check and drug screen
- 4. Be willing and able to perform physical work in all weather conditions

Applications:

- 1. Apply at UP Michigan Works! when application period is open generally once a year
- 2. Provide Social Security Card, Driver's License, and High School (or equivalent) transcripts while applying
- 3. Provide DD-214 if you are a veteran and wish to receive consideration for military training and/or experience
